WELCOME THE STRANGER

Have we forgotten Jesus' call to comfort the homeless and the stranger? We see them everyday and yet fail to act. The Lord loves the poor and wants to love them more deeply through you. "They shall bring all your brothers and sisters from all the nations . . . to Jerusalem, my holy mountain, says the Lord." In the three readings for this day, we are told that we are to welcome these strangers, to welcome the discipline of the Lord, which leads to peace, and to "strive to enter through the narrow gate" into the glory of God's own homeland, the reign of God.
