

THE DAYS ARE COMING



Separation, isolation, and hostility are terrible things. We are, sadly, too familiar with all of them in our modern life, no matter where we look. All three readings today refer to these same sad human conditions. The prophet Jeremiah describes world conditions as if the people of his time were sheep who had been scattered by poor leadership and corrupt shepherds. But "the days are coming,"

he assures us when a new shepherd, a just king, will come. We meet that king in the second reading and the Gospel. Paul reminds us in the Letter to the Ephesians that all divisions can now cease in Christ Jesus, who has brought us together through his blood. In Mark's Gospel we see Jesus himself, looking with pity on those searching for him as if they were sheep without a shepherd.

TODAY'S READINGS:	 First Reading – I shall gather the remnant of my flock and bring them back to their meadow (Jeremiah 23:1-6). Psalm – The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want (Psalm 23). Second Reading – You who were once far off have become near by the blood of Christ (Ephesians 2:13-18). Gospel – When Jesus saw the vast crowd, his heart was moved with pity for them, and he began to teach them many things (Mark 6:30-34).
